## Child Under 5 Years Information Sheet for TURTLE

*This form should be read to the child by a parent or guardian*

### What is the study about?

We are doing a study about a medicine called Secukinumab. The medicine might help children with sore eyes like you get better. Your mummy or daddy or another grown up who looks after you will read this leaflet to you.



### Do I have to take part?

No. You don't have to take part if you don't want to, it's up to you to choose after you talk to your mummy or daddy and they say it's ok too. If you do want to take part you can change your mind and stop taking part at any time.



### What will happen to me in the study?

Before we can give you the new medicine your doctor will have to check that it is safe for you to take. You will have to come to the hospital to do some tests and answer some questions about your new medicine.



### Will the new medicine make me feel better?

The new medicine might make you feel better but we can't be sure of this and your doctor will check you are ok.



### Will the new medicine make me poorly?

The medicine might make you feel poorly and you will have to tell your doctor or mummy or daddy if you feel sick or don't feel right. Your doctor will look after you to make sure you are ok after you have taken your medicine.



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## What are the good things about taking part in the study?

When you try a new medicine it can make you feel much better but we don't know for sure if it will help you. If the new medicine doesn't make you feel better the doctors can try and find out why, which could help other children like you get better in the future.



## What happens at the end of the study?

When the study finishes you might have to change medicine again. Your doctor will talk to you and your mummy or daddy about this.
